



## Technology Student Association Scholarship

Technology Student Association (TSA) high school seniors who have been accepted to an accredited university, community college, or technology center are invited to apply for the TSA Scholarship. Applicants must plan to pursue a degree or certification in a STEM-related field.

The TSA Scholarship Selection Committee will review all applications and make the final award recommendations. Scholarship recipients will be announced during the General Session at the State Conference.

Applications and all supporting documentation must be submitted through the scholarship portal on the OKTSA website by March 15 for consideration.

### APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Students who meet the following criteria are invited to apply.

#### Applicants must:

- Be a registered member of a TSA Chapter
- Be currently enrolled in high school and scheduled to graduate at the end of the current academic year.
- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.
- Have competed in at least one TSA competitive event during their high school career.
- Plan to attend an accredited college, university or technology center and pursue a degree or certification in a STEM-related field.

#### Additional information:

- Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the financial aid office of the recipient's college, university, or technology center. No funds will be provided directly to the student. Funds may be used to cover tuition, room and board, books, and/or fees during the student's freshman year.
- Scholarship awards are based on TSA involvement, academic achievement and potential, letters of recommendation, and the student's personal essay.
- Applicants must meet all admission and enrollment requirements of the institution they plan to attend.

### DEADLINE & APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications and all supporting documentation, including letters of recommendation, must be received by 11:59 p.m. on March 15.

Students must upload their application materials as a single PDF document through the scholarship portal on the OKTSA website. Letters of recommendation may be included in the PDF or submitted separately by the person providing the recommendation, but all required materials must be received by the deadline.
