

Technology Student Association Scholarship

Technology Student Association (TSA) high school seniors who have been accepted into an accredited university, community college or technology center for the Fall 2025 session are invited to apply for the TSA scholarship. Applicants must plan to pursue a degree or certification in a STEM related field.

The TSA Scholarship selection committee will review all applications and make final recommendations. The recipient of the scholarship will be announced at the State Conference awards ceremony. Application and all supporting documentation must be submitted to Tami Redus, Oklahoma State Advisor, by March 15th for consideration.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Students who meet the following criteria are invited to apply.

Applicants must:

- Be a registered student in a TSA Chapter
- Be currently enrolled in high school and scheduled to graduate at the end of the current academic year
- Have competed in a TSA Competition any year of their high school career
- Be in good academic standing
- Have taken either the SAT or the ACT
- Plan to attend an accredited college, university or technology center and have a declared major in a STEM related field

Additional information:

- All scholarship award payments will be forwarded to the financial aid office at the university. No funds will be provided directly to the student. Funds may be used to help pay for tuition, room and board, books, and/or fees during the student's freshman year.
- Awards are based on years of TSA involvement, academic potential, achievement, recommendation, and the student's personal essay.
- Applicants must meet all minimum enrollment qualifications required by the university.

DEADLINE & APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications and all supporting documentation, including letters of recommendation, must be received by 11:59 pm on March 15th. To apply, students may email their application to the TSA State Advisor or mail a paper copy to the TSA State Office.
